

November 19 - World Toilet Day: The SFA Group Mobilizes Once Again

True to its commitment to ensuring access to sanitation for all, the SFA Group has been commemorating **World Toilet Day** (November 19) for several years by sponsoring solidarity initiatives around the world.

After projects in France (2011, 2018, 2019), Cambodia (2016), and Senegal (2017), the French Group, inventor of the Sanibroyeur®, has been financially supporting since 2023 the Sulabh School Sanitation Club in India, with the main objective of improving quality of life in Indian schools.

At the same time, the program has a tangible impact on the daily lives of students and school staff through the distribution of hygiene kits, interactive training sessions, and practical workshops on health and hygiene education.

To date, nearly 900 students from around ten schools in the provinces of Haryana (4 schools in 2023 - 250 students) and Sikkim (3 schools in 2024 - 296 students, and 3 new ones planned for 2025¹ i.e. 314 students) have benefited from

For 2025, the focus has been placed on menstrual dignity, with the creation of a dedicated handwashing area and two sanitary blocks adapted to the specific needs of girls, along with training sessions aimed at addressing menstrual management with respect, confidence, and peace of mind.

SFA Group's financial support. Each year, this support enables the complete renovation of toilets, the creation of dedicated handwashing areas, and the installation of separate spaces for girls, facilitating menstrual hygiene management. These clean, well-equipped facilities help reduce infections and the spread of disease, while also encouraging school attendance—especially among young girls.
